Here is a little guide to the brands I use and love.

## **Ranger Alcohol Ink:**

Ranger inks is one of my favourite inks. They come in many different shades and are cheaper than many of the other brands. The colours are true to how they are represented and I have never been disappointed when using them.

## Pinata Alcohol Ink:

These inks are more pigmented than any of the other brands I use. They are great to use in resin but I often find them too bright for my ink paintings.

# **Copic Ink Refill**

This brand has been my go-to for a very long time. They come in an impressive range of shades and are very easy to use. Unfortunately Copic has changed their bottles to contain less ink for the same amount of money, and I will no longer be able to use Copic.

#### Мерху

This brand is new to me. They look very similar to Copic with the advantage of containing more ink than the old Copic refills for less money. They are free standing and sturdy so they stand more easily than the other brands. They also claim to be nontoxic (an advantage on the other brands). Unfortunately I have found that they fade when using them with resin. I am also concerned about the colours which are not always accurately represented on their chart and on the bottles.

#### **Couture Inks**

Couture Inks is another brand that is new to me. They look like the Ranger bottles, but have less colours available. So far I have been happy with the brand. The colours are nice and true to representation.

# ShinHan Touch Refill Inks

Yet another brand that is new to me. These inks looks similar to Copic, they come in many different shades and contains 20ml of ink. They are reasonably priced and have been very enjoyable to work with. The colours are true to representation and they work well in resin. This brand is so far my favourite brand to work with.
